Our Museum is open to the public, weekdays, 10:00 am to 4:00 pm. The last tour begins at 3:00 pm. Tours are free of charge but donations are encouraged. Twelve exquisite Rolls-Royce and Bentley motorcars are on permanent display at our World-Class Museum. We offer numerous tours to many groups such as school children, church groups, retirement home groups, car clubs, scouts, etc.

Our Research Center is also open to the public. Hours are Monday - Friday 10:00 am - 3:00 pm. Qualified researchers may make special arrangements for access to the archives by contacting the Foundation.

We Help to Educate the Next Generation – In 2012, we funded scholarships and loaned cars at two local colleges who offer degrees in automotive technology: Harrisburg Area Community College (HACC) and Pennsylvania College of Technology (PCT). This is in addition to the Foundation's long standing commitment to McPherson College (KS).

We Work to Preserve our History - In 2012, we funded a project to scan thousands of original Factory and Dealer warranty records on Rolls-Royce and Bentley motorcars delivered to North America from 1976 through 2000. We also made available The Rossfeldt Collection - possibly the largest collection of Rolls-Royce and Bentley digital images anywhere in the world! This fabulous collection consists of approximately 40,000 photo images on about 1,600 Rolls-Royce and Bentley motorcars. The file size of some images is over 250MB. The Rossfeldt Collection consists of 457 GB of data.

We Provide the World's Foremost Experts on Rolls-Royce and Bentley - In 2012, Sir David Plastow, Chairman of Rolls-Royce Motor Cars (RRMC) from 1972 to 1980 delivered a Keynote Session at the RROC Annual Meet. This was a once in a lifetime opportunity to hear from the Chairman of RRMC during a period of great tumult in RR history.

We Support Several Public, Charitable Works – Our world class car collection is always on the move, participating in several national and local events. We exhibited our 1936 Bentley 3.5-Litre Sedan Coupe, Hooper at the showroom of Sun Porsche in Mechanicsburg on Friday, October 19, 2012. This car was a participant at the prestigious Hershey d'Elegance, the St. Michael's Concours d'Elegance and the Radnor Hunt Concours d'Elegance. Our Silver Cloud was also displayed at the Glenview Mansion at the Rockville, Maryland Car Show. We also participated in a benefit for the Central Pennsylvania Chapter of the National MS Society and its inaugural Mile for MS road rally. We exhibited at the Frost Bite Tour of nearby Lancaster County and Amish Country.
